Our completely donor-supported operation works with homeless youth under the age of 23 to assist them by providing not only basic, life-stabilizing services, but also by providing proactive contacts with other agencies/services and case managers to help them work toward becoming self-sufficient and independent. Our Drop-in Center is located in Anoka, MN, and is open M-F, from 2 p.m. – 7 p.m., and offers youth the opportunity to have a warm nutritious meal, shower, do laundry, visit the food pantry, visit the free clothing “store”, visit a weekly health clinic, seek work through job boards, and computers, along with other services in our safe and secure environment.

We are seeking a Case Manager to work with Youth who use the services at our Drop-in Center. This is a FT position, responsible for developing rapport with youth in order to complete intake and assessments that provide informed referrals to youth service providers, while maintaining a safe, comfortable and welcoming environment for the youth who are at the Center using its services. This role is responsible for retaining that relationship to provide after-care services to youth keeping them on the path to stabilization and independence. Qualified candidates will have a 4-year degree in Human Services or related field, and/or three years’ experience in a related field. Experience working in HMIS State database, preferred, but not required.
