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The Darkest Night of Your Life 4K Allows Participants to Experience What Homeless Youth Face When They Are on the Streets

Coon Rapids, Minnesota – April 11, 2019 – On any given night, there are more than 6,000 homeless youth in Minnesota and when the darkness of night sets in, these young people are staying in shelters, couch-hopping or sleeping on the streets. HOPE 4 Youth, a nonprofit that provides pathways to end youth homelessness, is raising awareness of their plight, as well as funds, by bringing the community together for the fourth annual *The Darkest Night of Your Life 4K* on Friday, May 3rd at Bunker Hills Golf Club.

Participants will experience many of the same things as homeless young people – darkness, loneliness, cold and quiet – while they walk/run the 4K to support homeless youth, as well as raise funds to ensure they have the tools needed so they never have to experience them again. Much like Erin, a formerly homeless young person who, rather than stay in a dysfunctional home, was sleeping in apartment complex alleyways. When we learned of Erin and her situation, our Case Manager found her and brought her to HOPE 4 Youth. Erin did not want to stay in a shelter and luckily HOPE 4 Youth was able to place her at HOPE Place, transitional living program, very quickly. Since finding her new home, she has graduated from Andover High School with honors and is now in college, working towards a music degree.
