Job Role: HOPE 4 Youth Drop-in Center Intern **Purpose:** The purpose of this role is to assist with HOPE 4 Youth programs. **Drop-In Center:** 2665 4th Avenue North, Suite #40, Anoka, MN 55303

Key Responsibilities:

- Function as a mentor volunteer to ensure that Outreach/Drop-In Center needs are met (not limited to: cleaning, clerical, mentoring youth)
- Working with and shadowing Youth Coordinators with a variety of clients to gain an understanding of case management.
- Documenting processes in client track, folders, or other necessary places.
- Completing a variety of projects around the drop-in center such as organization or research on resources.
- Attending meetings within the organization and community.

Reports to: Drop-In Center Program Coordinator

Time Commitment: Must be willing to commit to 8 weeks.

Qualifications:

- Bachelors level student studying for a degree in human services, youth development, social work, or any other related field.
- Volunteers must have a passion for serving youth experiencing homelessness.
- Volunteers must uphold the HOPE 4 Youth core values: resourceful, accountable, inclusive, hopeful, and compassionate.
- Background check

Required Training:

- On-site training at each location.
- On-site shadowing with Youth Coordinator
- Attend "A Look Inside Hope"
- YIPA trainings
- Mandated Reporter training

Who: Individuals 21+ attending a HOPE 4 Youth approved college and program.

Dress Code: Casual, unless otherwise required for meetings.
