WHAT DOES A DONATIONS VOLUNTEER DO?

As a donations volunteer, there are many different tasks and areas to work in during the shift.

- Greeter: Meet and greet donors as they drop off items and support carrying in donations.
- Sorter: Check donations for quality, sort, and weigh items.
- Pantry: Date food, organize pantry storage, and stock pantry shelves.
- Closet: Sort, organize, and hang clothing.
