WHAT DOES A PANTRY RESTOCK DO?

As a pantry restock volunteer, you stock the food and hygiene pantry in the morning before we open to the youth

- Restock the low or empty areas of the food and hygiene sections.
- Check dates of shelved items for expiration dates.
- Tidy shelves and storage area
- Notify Community Engagement Coordinator of low items.



WHAT SHOULD I WEAR?

Choose comfortable clothes that are easy to move in. Pick items that allow you to move, lift, stand, and bend. Most people choose jeans and tennis shoes – but feel free to wear what is comfortable for you!
