WHAT DOES A MEAL SERVER DO?

As a meal server, you will:

- Provide a welcoming and safe environment for the youth.
- Prepare the main meal and sides for dinner service.
- Serve dinner to youth in small groups of 6-8 by plating meal or having counter ready for youth to plate on their own.
- Follow required food safety guidelines.
 These are outlined in our "HOPE 4 Youth Kitchen Guidelines" document.
- Package leftovers from the dinner meal to be served for lunches the next day.
- Clean kitchen area after meal.
