Without an ID Jocelyn was not able to apply for a job – one of the first steps to no longer being homeless. After obtaining her ID, and with the help of her HOPE 4 Youth Case Manager and Jenilee from the Workforce Center, she was able to find a job. Even though she is now working, she continues to meet with a Case Manager regularly at our Drop-In Center to work on independent living skills and accesses the resources she needs so she can find stable, long-term housing and get further on her pathway to success.
