- > Partnership with Hope for the Community We are thrilled to share we have the appliances in house and have our first order ready to be delivered next week. We believe our issue of food insecurity has been solved through this developing partnership. While there are a few challenges to overcome, we are working through them one at a time. We will provide a full recap at May's board meeting.
- ۶ Building HOPE Project – As shared at the board meeting, after three LOIs in the Northtown Mall area, we have exhausted all options there and have moved on. We are exploring a Blaine location off Hwy 65 – more to come! I have re-engaged city staff at both Blaine and Fridley to keep us on their radar.
- > Comprehensive Campaign I continue to meet with individuals "in the know" pertaining to capital campaign work. We tested the idea of a Naming Campaign with our Dvlpmt Committee and campaign consultants. We are pivoting our proposed Naming Campaign to an enhanced Comprehensive Campaign vision. I have three meetings this week but will update you soon.
