HOT topics on the horizon...

- ▶ Building HOPE Project As shared in our board meeting, we are moving through our due diligence period with positive results day after day! The work we are doing today will shape HOPE 4 Youth's future for every youth walking through our doors.
 - As of Tuesday July 29th, we have exercised a 30-day extension period pertaining to our 8565 Central Ave property closing. As we work through due diligence and bridge loan needs, our appreciation is shared with each of you; thank you for your insight, talent, and expertise.
 - We used our <u>Building HOPE Project case study</u> to secure the \$8M DEED Grant. Please use and share this document to build awareness and understanding of our expansion need. Our 6000 SF rental facility can no longer provide adequate space for our increased youth numbers and needed resources. Moving into a nearly 12K SF facility will allow us to expand partner engagement, youth resource connection, and so much more.
 - We hope to formally launch our private phase of the *Mission Expansion* element of our comprehensive fundraising campaign.
