- Building HOPE Project We are moving through our due diligence period with positive results day after day! Here is a quick snapshot.
 - DEED has accepted our application and moved it to the next stage – MMB's approval. Agreement will follow.
 - We are at the underwriting phase of securing our bridge loan. We hope to close on first part of August.
 - The Building Committee will review the bids from our construction firms on June 27^{th,} recommending a partner for the Executive Committee's approval.
 - City zoning approval complete.
 - Property survey complete.
 - o Title Work almost complete.
 - Bank loan appraisal inspecting location on the 26th
 - Building interior environmental work in review phase report due on June 30.
 - Phase I environmental work report due to H4Y on July 3rd
 - Comprehensive Campaign's assets are complete while researching tier-one outreach plans for late August after we close.

Administrative connections — We have committed to quarterly trainings for our team. In June we had a retirement planning expert present to the team. H4Y has a 3% retirement match for all staff who participate in the program. We are additionally exploring how AI will benefit H4Y in process and creation.
